12.45 Lunch at Newland ** Bring your own lunch **. 13.45 Depart - 2 miles, up a track and across fields.

14.35 Arrive Clearwell. 14.50 Depart - 3 miles, across a common, through Sling and along forestry track. 16.15 Arrive Broadwell, Good Shepherd 20 min worship then refreshments, Finish by about **17.15**.
